

# **BIOGRAPHY**



## **COLONEL JOHN RHOADES**

Colonel John Rhoades is the Vice Commander of the Rocky Mountain Region (RMR). In this role, Col. Rhoades assists and advises the region commander in leading and managing more than 4,000 volunteer professionals and over \$30 million in assets across Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Utah, and Wyoming to execute CAP's three-fold mission of emergency services, aviation, space and cyber education, and youth leadership development.

Col. Rhoades joined CAP in 1994 as a cadet in the Louisiana Wing. Shortly thereafter, he moved to Texas and was a charter member of the Nacogdoches Composite Squadron where he served as cadet commander and earned his Billy Mitchell Award. In 1996, he moved to Alabama and transferred to the Bessemer Composite Squadron, earning his Eaker Award and serving as Squadron



Cadet Commander, Chairman of the Alabama Wing Cadet Advisory Council, and Cadet Commander of the 1997 AL/MS Wing Encampment. In addition, he participated in the International Air Cadet Exchange Program to Israel.

As a Senior Member, Col. Rhoades has served in numerous staff positions at the squadron, group, and wing level, including Colorado Wing Commander, Colorado Military Academy Cadet Squadron Commander, Bessemer Composite Squadron Commander, and Alabama Wing Chief of Staff. He holds Master ratings in Command, Stan/Eval, Cadet Programs, and Personnel, as well as senior ratings in Operations and Emergency Services. Additionally, he is a Command Pilot, Check Pilot Examiner and Incident Commander and has earned the Master Ground Team Badge and Emergency Medical Technician Badge.

Col. Rhoades currently serves in the U.S. Navy Reserves as an intelligence officer assigned to the NORAD/USNORTHCOM Joint Intelligence Directorate. He is a qualified Information Warfare Officer and previous assignments include the Office of Naval Intelligence and the Defense Intelligence Agency's Missile and Space Intelligence Center. He also deployed abroad with Patrol Squadron 69 in support of operation Pacific Eagle.

Col. Rhoades completed his primary flight training as a CAP cadet and is currently employed as a pilot, simulator check pilot and Part 142 Training Center Evaluator on the Boeing 757/767. He holds Airline Transport Certificates issued by the FAA, the UK Civil Aviation Authority, and the Japan Civil Aeronautics Bureau with CL-65, A320, B757 and B767 type ratings. He also holds a commercial glider certificate and is an active CFI/CFII/MEI.

The colonel has over 13,500 hours of flight time including 2000 hours in command of B767 and more than 2500 hours in general aviation aircraft.
