3 goals of Cadet Advisory Council

- 1) Provide an organization where cadets receive better leadership experience in higher organizational levels
- 2) Aid the commander in managing and implementing the Cadet Program
- 3) Make recommendations to improve the running of the Cadet Program

- 1) Group
 - 2) Wing
 - 3) Regional
 - 4) National

- Created CAC constitution
